How to apply for admission

- (i) Aspirants are required to registered themselves by applying online for admission entrance test through the link available on the website. A registration fee of Rs. 800/- (Rs. 400 for SC and ST candidates) will be deposited at the time of registration.
- (ii) A computer-based entrance test will be conducted by the University in various centers established in Dehradun, Delhi, Lucknow, Haldwani.
- (iii) The outline of entrance test paper has been given in the prospectus. Candidates are advised to make preparations accordingly. After the Entrance test, result will be declared and merit list will be published through the website.

Declaration of Results and Merit list

- (i) Entrance test merit lists of the candidates for admission to various courses shall be displayed on the University's website. There shall be separate lists for the General Category and Reservation Categories.
- (ii) Selected applicants should report for admission counseling and complete all admission formalities. If an applicant fails to do so, (s)he shall automatically forfeit his/her right to admission.

Admission Counseling

Successful applicants called for admission should bring originals and attested copies of the required documents at the time of admission counseling. Final Admission will be subject to submission of required documents and verification of documents.

Details of programs and eligibility criteria for Admission

For seeking admission to a Programme and School of one's choice, eligibility requirements are as follows. Please note that even 49.9% or 44.9% or 54.9% marks obtained by an applicant in the qualifying exam shall not be considered as 50% or 45% or 55% respectively.
