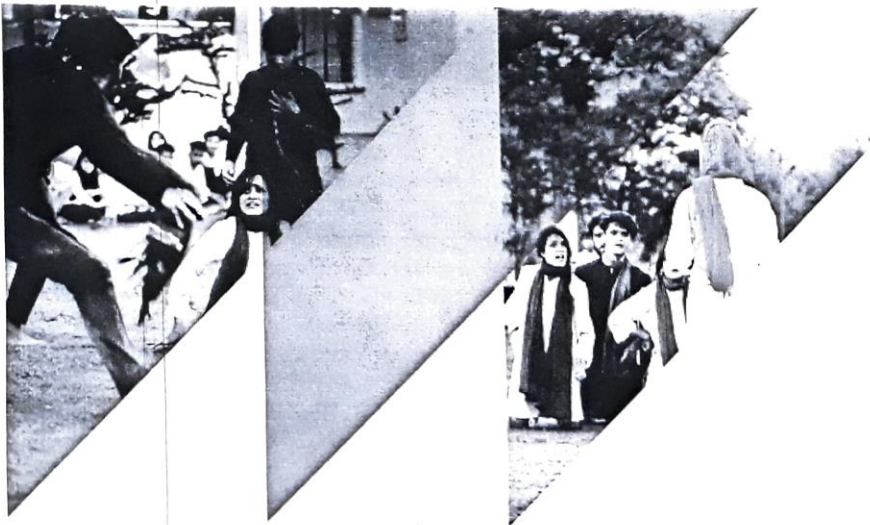

Doon University wins 1st Prize in National Debate Competition

By OUR STAFF REPORTER DEHRADUN, 21 Mar: The Doon University won the first prize in the prestigious 7th edition of the Inter-University National Debate Competition held at Jamia Milia Islamia Central University, New Delhi.

On the basis of overall performance, Doon University was awarded the first prize, which was held by Delhi University, last year. Participating in the 'Dr Zakir Hussain Memorial Debate', titled 'This house believes that the millennial generation is post racial', the team of Ujjwal Sharma, third year student of BSc, Economics, and Yashi Singh, first year student of German language, won the first prize in Hindi language. Abhinandan Garg, first year student of MA, Spanish Language, and Ashutosh Srivastav, first year student, BSc, Economics, won the third prize in English language. The debate was organised in three languages - Hindi, English and Urdu.

Absaar Abbasi, Cultural Committee Member and Assistant Professor at School of Media and Communication, Doon University, stated that a total of 42 teams participated in the debate competition. Four universities from Uttarakhand, including Doon University and Pantnagar University, participated in the competition. Apart from the trophies, the first prize winning team was awarded Rs 5000 in cash, while third prize winners were awarded Rs 2000.

Expressing happiness and satisfaction at the performance of the students at the national level, Vice Chancellor Dr CS Nautiyal personally congratulated the winners and had a word of encouragement for them. "It is a matter of pride for the Doon University family, in particular, and the state of Uttarakhand, in general, that our students are bringing laurels to the university," he said, adding that the varsity administration would do everything to promote such competitions and prepare students to meet the challenges of today's world.

"Nanda ki Katha" or "The Story of Nanda" is a dance-song based drama on the folk saga of Nanda Devi, which is well-known in the state of Uttarakhand. This dance song drama has been adapted from prevalent folk beliefs about the Goddess Nanda, who the people of Uttarakhand revere. The entire saga of Nanda, or the myth of Nanda, is commonplace in the oral tradition in the state of Uttarakhand in the form of folk songs and religious songs called jagars. This tradition is believed to have been in practice here for over more than 1000 years. The rural community of the state considers Nanda Devi not only as a form of a Goddess but also as Disa Dhyani, a Garhwali connotation that translates into English as "a married daughter". While the deity is worshipped as a Goddess by the people of Uttarakhand, she is also celebrated as a daughter and a daughter-in-law. There is a tradition in Nanda Devi jagars are sung for many days across Uttarakhand with variations and Uttarakhand to sing the popular folk tales of Nanda Devi through jagars and songs. modalities.
