Soft skills are a major part of a student's professional journey and the University takes concrete measures to nurture and enhance it. These programs are conducted both in house and through outsourced partners.

The University has signed MoU with a top soft skill training company Cresnet Systems (Global Voice, Mohali). The MoU covers training on English Language, soft skills and life skills.

Another MoU with Score Academy Dehradun facilitated training in English Language and guidance on IELTS/PTE to the students who aspired to study abroad. The organization will further help the students to get sensitized in International careers.

An MoU was signed with Times of India, Chandigarh division. This MoU focuses on providing summer internships to the students of Management followed training through guest lectures on skills required by students to excel in the corporate world. This MoU covers engagement of students through live projects and stipend based summer internship program.

Another MoU was signed with Greenpanel Industries Ltd. This MoU focussed on guest lectures and internships for the students and 'Knowledge enhancement' for the students of the University through skill enhancement sessions and making the students aware of the latest trends in the industry.

An MoU signed between Doon University and Any Tech Ventures Pvt Ltd. Facilitated internships, workshops on skill enhancements and guest lecture on trending topics like Artificial Intelligence and Business Analytics.

Prof HJ Ghosh Roy took a detailed workshop on skill building to excel in career and covered how to choose the right career path, for the students of the school of Management. Prof. Meththika Vithanage from University of Sri Jayewardenepura, Sri Lanka delivered sessions on Life skill development and shared the importance of Human, conceptual and technical skills For the School of Environment and Natural Resources

**Department of Spanish Studies**, School of Languages, Doon University organised a one-day International Symposium on History of Ideas: Latin America and India in 20th Century on **May 15, 2021** through a virtual platform. The coordinator of the program was Dr. Mala Shikha, Assistant Professor, Department of Spanish Studies. The program was inaugurated by Hon'ble VC, Prof Surekha Dangwal. She emphasized on the importance for the intellectual connections in these times where geographical containment is observed due to the pandemic.

The convenor Dr. Mala Shikha also highlighted on the need for understanding the nature of Indian reception in Latin America since the dawn of Modernism till the present times, and to also look into the de-colonial and post colonial experiences of both the cultures in the last century.

There were four distinguished speakers of Hispanic Studies in India and abroad who conducted four technical sessions.

Discussions on internationalism, pink tide and indigenous epistemologies like the idea of *Buen Vivir* were conducted by **Dr. Ash Narain Roy, Director of Institute of Social Sciences, New Delhi.**

A session on Octavio Paz's oeuvre on India and drawing connections with his studies on Claude Levi Strauss and Nagarajuna's Madhyamika philosophy was conducted by **Prof. Minni Sawhney, Department of Germanic and Romance Studies, University of Delhi.**

An elucidation on the ideas present in the late 19<sup>th</sup> century Latin America and their role in challenging the prevalent utilitarian ideas of the USA with the support of the Indian presence was done by **Prof. Shyama Prasad Ganguly, a retired professor from JNU, New Delhi.**

A talk on the political and aesthetic gaze of various Latin American intellectual travellers, with special focus on Julio Cortazar and Juan Sklar from Argentina, was conducted by **Dr. Lucia Caminada Rossetti**, a tenured professor at the **University of Nordeste in Argentina, Latin America.**

The program was attended by the **100 participants**, both faulty members and students, who registered for the event from various national as well as international institutions from all over the world.

**Friday Lecture Series :** An engaging and informative online session was conducted under the Doon University's initiative, academic and social, the Friday Lecture Series on May 27, 2021. This session of the lecture series was organized by the Doon Academic Forum for Combating COVID 19 (DUAFFC), Dehradun.

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The patron of the event, Hon'ble VC Prof. Surekha Dangwal, said that Doon University is committed to the cause of providing relief in COVID times by creating awareness, providing consultation and by indulging in other relief & rescue work.

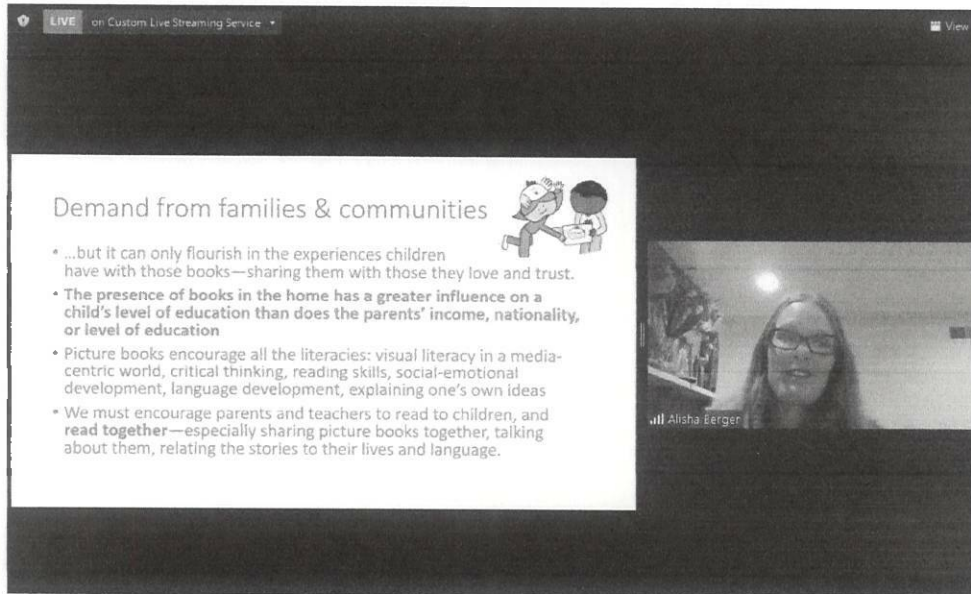

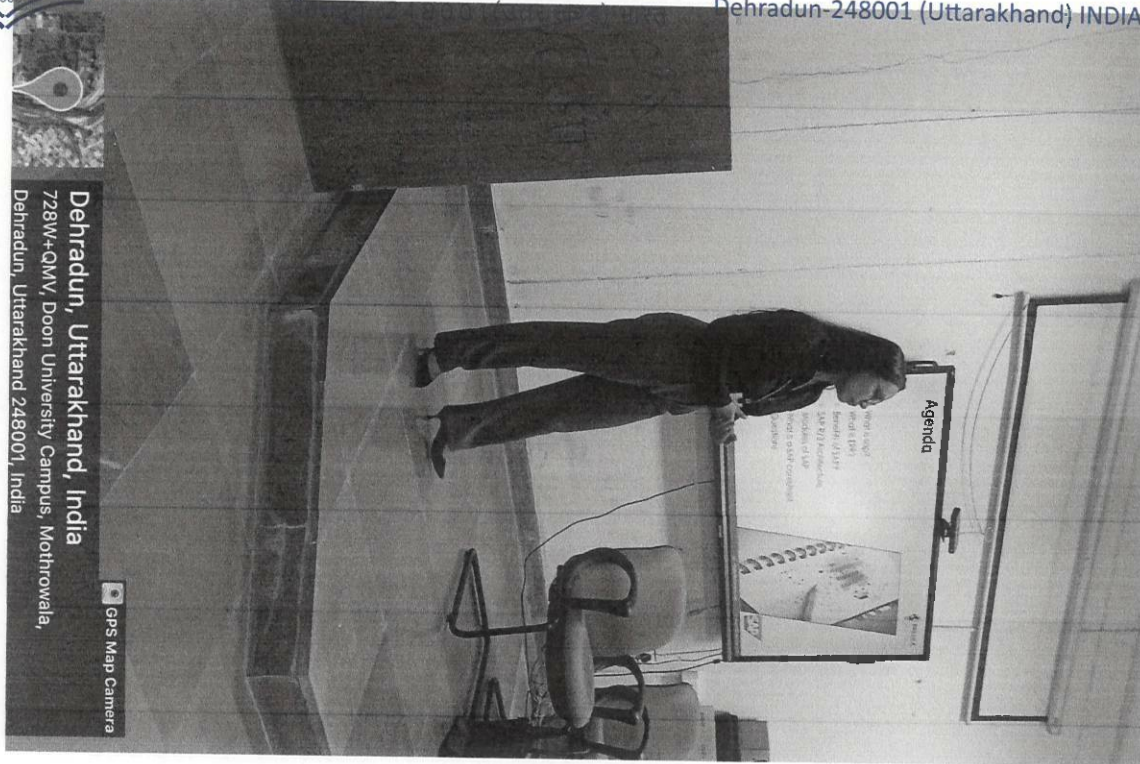
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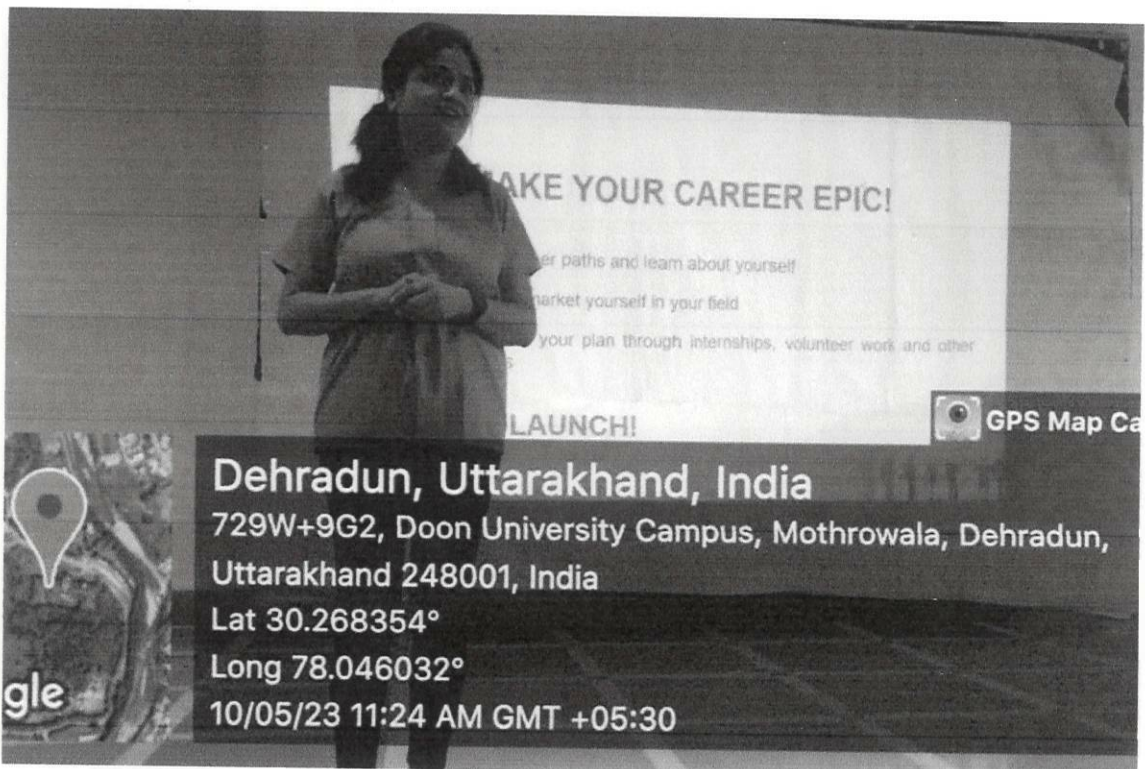

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## Introduction to E Press Reader

In today's digital age, mobile app-based learning has gained significant importance. With the widespread use of smartphones and tablets, mobile apps provide a convenient and accessible platform for learning anytime and anywhere. 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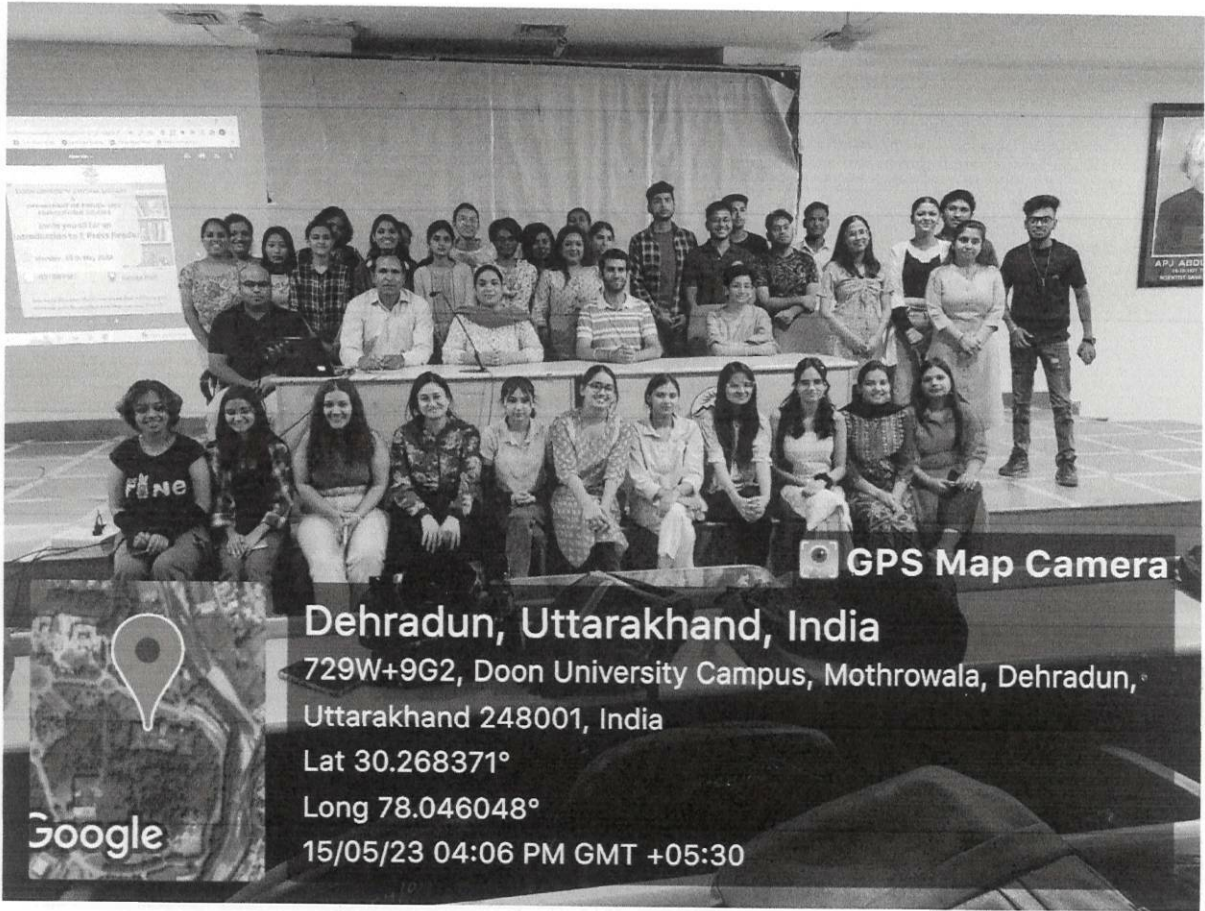
