ONE YEAR CERTIFICATE COURSE IN GERMAN LANGUAGE

Programme Description: This programme on offer, Certificate Course in French, is meant for students, working professionals or anyone interested in learning French language as a hobby. This programme is offered over two semesters where each semester includes 30 lectures (45 contact hours).

Program Outcome (PO): To introduce and equip the students with basic level skills of German language vis-à-vis four language skills i.e. listening, speaking, reading, writing and cultural competence.

Program Specific Outcome (PSO): Students are able to communicate at basic level in German language.

Eligibility: Senior Secondary Certificate (SSC) passed with minimum of 50% marks scored. It is equivalent to the twelfth grade or the final year of secondary education in India. There may be an entrance examination conducted by Doon University.

Frequency, Timings & Duration: Twice a week in the evening weekday hours (after 5 pm); 3 lecture hours/ week. 90 lecture units (45 x 2) for two semesters; 135 hours of teaching.

- CO3 Develop an understanding of German culture apart from developing skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing in German language.

Detailed Course Structure

Course Description: The one-year certificate course offered by the Department of German Studies as a part-time regular course for candidates interested in learning German. It is designed to suit the needs of working professionals, students who are pursuing other full-time programs and those who want to pursue the language out of career interests or hobby.

Course outline: The course generally runs parallel to the university semesters and each semester ends with written and oral examinations of 50 marks each.
