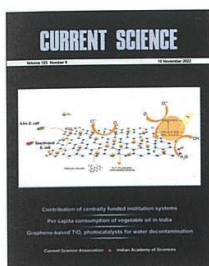

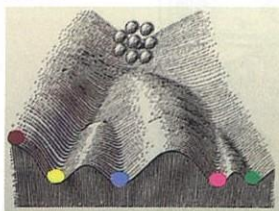
- ◀ COVER. Schematic view of the photocatalytic response of TiO₂-RGO for the decomposition of water contaminants. See page 1089.

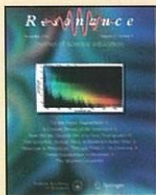

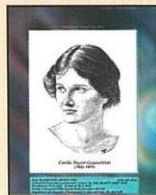

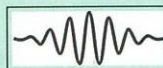
